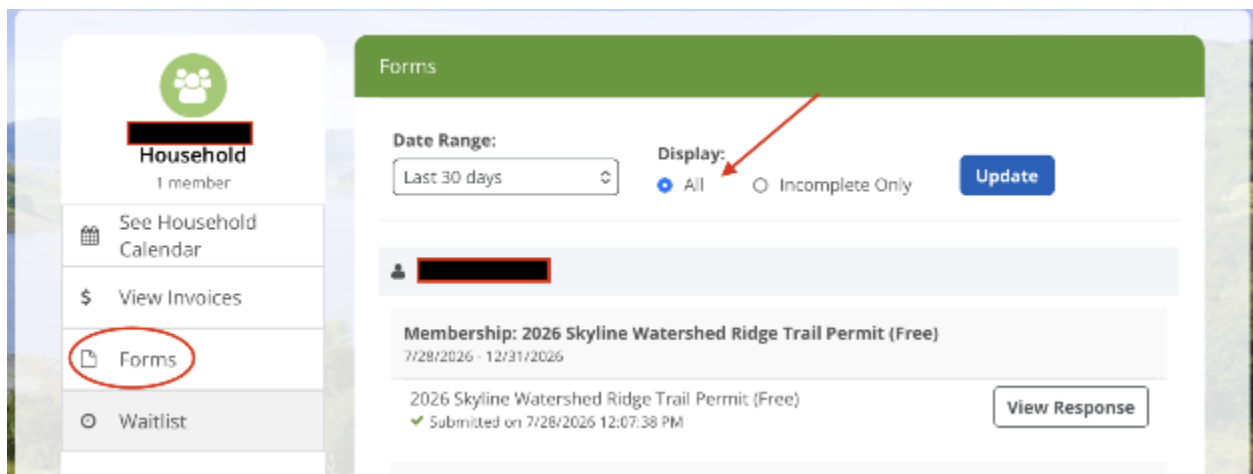


**For help with obtaining a permit, please review the Step-by-Step Guide in the Trails section under Information and Forms.**
